It's the May edition of Uni Gliding and I find myself writing the *President's Report*. How on earth did this happen? Well, let's see. It's August 1987 and I accompany my brother to the Lochiel gliding field and get an hour flight with Redmond Quinn. I enjoy it, so join the club. Early visits are infrequent, Stephen Were tells me if I want to progress I should fly a bit more regularly than every six months. I heed his advice and fly regularly through winter 1989. However about October cricket starts again and I stop flying. I attend the 1990 AGM. I resume playing football after a 3 year break and continue to not fly. When the season ends I see there is a flying camp coming up so decide to go after having set foot on field only once in the preceding 12 months. Stephen re-enters the story now as the instructor which I drive mad for a whole week, trying to show him every possible way of doing a bad landing. With 5 club aircraft we seem to have a never ending maintenance and inspection workload. Almost all of this work is carried out within the club.

A dedicated band of club members spend endless nights at the club's maintenance facility keeping the fleet airworthy so we all can fly. Since January we have been working on a major 20 yearly inspection on an ES60B Super Arrow which the club acquired last year. This aircraft is expected to reenter service in the next few weeks.

A copy of the 1992 club maintenance programme is included in this months newsletter. It doesn't take an extensive study of this to understand why the dedicated band would like some more helpers. For the uninitiated a "form 2" is the annual inspection every glider must undergo. The maintenance schedule also shows scheduled maintenance on 4 privately owned aircraft which operate with the club and a sorely needed extension of the West Beach workshop.

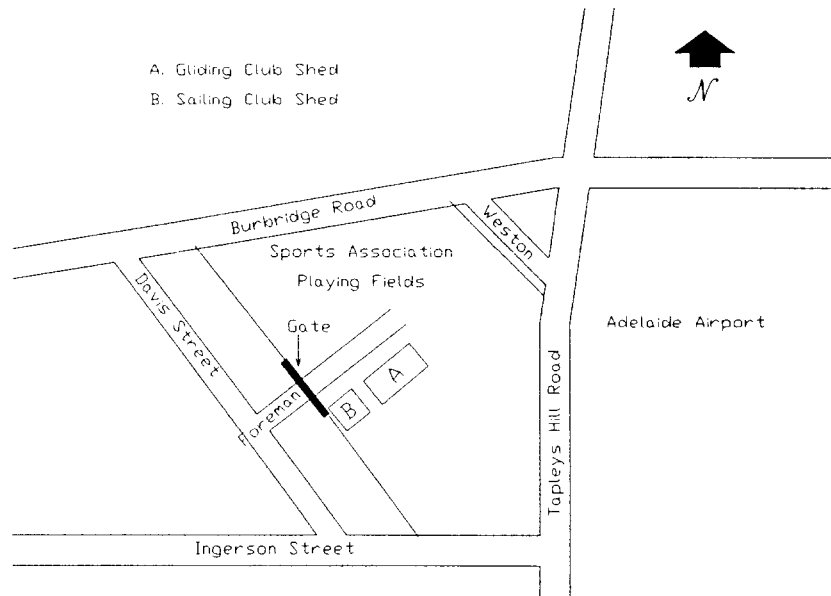
Most work is carried out on our aircraft on weeknights except Friday. If you can spare a night give Redmond Quinn or Dave Conway a call:

Black Springs Expedition Finds No Evidence Of Global Warming

For the past three years the AUGC has accompanied Adelaide Soaring Club on their annual expedition to Black Springs. Black Springs is a small cross road about 30km south of Burra. Nearby is a ridge suitable for soaring in westerlies, similar winds to those required for ridge soaring at Lochiel. This annual expedition has traditionally involved a tow plane from Gawler flying up to provide the launching service for a variety of club and privately owned gliders trailered to the site. Conditions at the 'airfield' are primitive: it's just a farmer's paddock with no facilities. Tents are set up under the trees at the base of the ridge, along with a rented porta-loo. In past years, flying at Black Springs has provided an interesting and fun contrast to Lochiel, with good soaring over different countryside. This year was no exception.

The long weekend of the Adelaide Cup (May 16-18) saw a sizable contingent of AUGC'ers (and a few associated hangers-on) head for the Black Springs site with three gliders in tow: the club's Libelle (Charlie) and the private gliders TeX and Oscar (another Libelle and the Pik). These joined three other gliders from the Gawler club; two single seaters and a two-seater, a Twin Astir. This fleet was somewhat smaller than in previous years: perhaps because of a potentially dismal weather forecast.

By Saturday afternoon, the weather forecast was falling into disrepute: some of the best flying in a very long time was starting to accrue. I was in Charlie: a short tow to 1300 feet and I released in weak but smooth lift. In what seemed like no time I was passing cloudbase in wave lift in clear air right ahead of a most spectacular cloud, a thousand feet high and 3 or 4 kilometres long, which provided a truly stunning backdrop against which to chase the other Libelle back and forth without the effort of working to maintain constant height. With the sun low in the west, we were rewarded by the sight, so rare in normal gliding, of our shadows cast on the cloud, surrounded by the full rainbow (many people don't realise that rainbows are completely circular: from the earth bound viewpoint however the ground gets in the way to obscure the bottom half of the rainbow.) A stunning time for the pilots airborne, finished all too soon by the imminent approach of darkness. My own flight ended after a high speed chase of Tex across the valley from the west, along the ridge, through a couple of wingovers and into a circuit for near simultaneous landings.

The weather continued to be kind that night as the camp site was prepared, the campfire was started, the dinner cooked in the Weber, and the mysteries of the porta-loo were fathomed. (Water was added to every orifice of this mechanical monstrosity before it was finally brought up to full functionality. At no time did it throw out more than a couple of its occupants and no further than two or three metres).

Sunday saw more good flying: no wave today, but thermals and even some ridge lift. Most people found they could save launch costs by releasing from the tow plane at 600-700 feet and heading straight for the ridge. Not a very high day with cloudbase at only 2300 feet, but much fun was had by all. By the end of the afternoon, the cloud had expanded to a dark overcast and the weather forecast unleashed the torrential downpour (actually, it was fairly light, but genuinely tested the waterproofness of everyone's tents). Dinner was prepared under shelter and the rain was generally cold and wet. Luckily by morning, the skies were clear once again, leaving a group of frozen pilots to thaw out by folding sodden tents and sleeping bags, then prepare for more ridge flying: the weather was good for flying yet again. All too soon the weekend was at an end and by mid-afternoon we were derigging and loading the gliders back into their trailers. All of us, that is, except the BASTARDS that got to fly the two seater back to Gawler behind the tug aircraft (I'm still not sure what you had to do to pull that one off, Catherine! especially after David and Agata on the Saturday managed to score the flight up to Black Springs) had a boring drive home towing trailers. A great weekend, leaving all who attended in eager anticipation of the 1993 Black Springs Expedition.
