Maurie has just returned from Turkey and the World Air Games and is certain to have some entertaining stories for the bar afterwards.

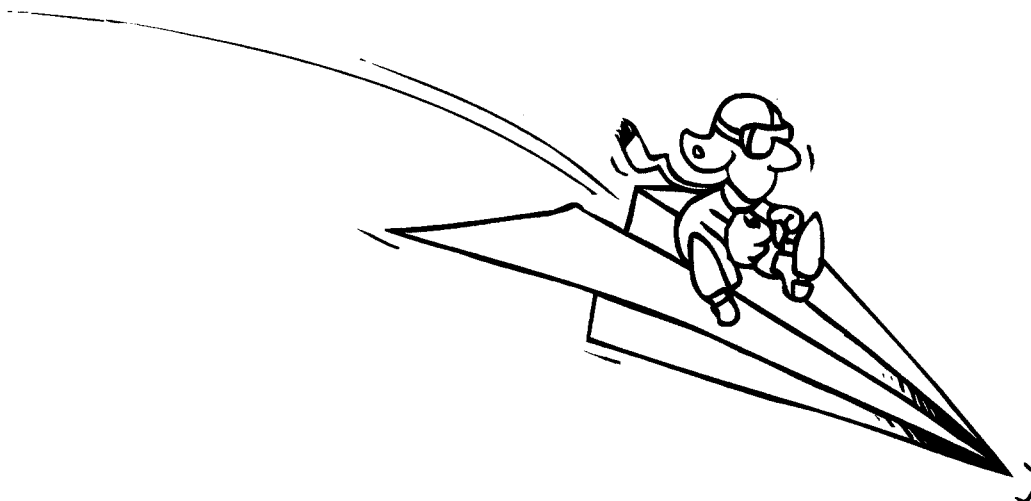
INDOOR ROCKCLIMBING
